

Communication / Expert groups

CA do need input on QA/QC matters

Advice on interpretation of QA/QC info, technical specifications etc

BUT national structures do vary considerably

**National expert group => national contact point
QA/QC**

**EU expert groups very necessary to provide input
to national structure
e.g. feasibility and disproportionate cost**

**Criteria from QA/QC directive need to be checked
National solutions:**

- accreditation (contract review)**
- Notification (expert advice for CA)**

**Harmonisation needed (PT frequency,
assessment)**

A lot already going on

**Sector specific assessment criteria for WFD
should be set at EU level**

**Project should recommend such criteria
To be used in accreditation or notification**

Guidance for accreditation bodies

**Collect good / bad practices and provide feedback
(EU expert group, EUROLAB, ...)**

**Network of PT providers
Should be as large as possible
Market forces will ensure provision of PTs**

PT providers should be accredited

Training is part of PT
